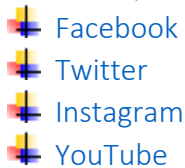
Who was Charles Darwin?

SUMMARY:

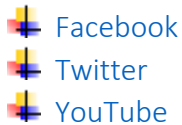

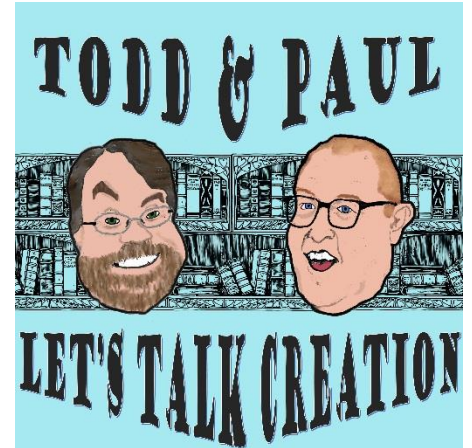
